## **SECRETARY REPORT – DISTRICT 12 MEETING – DECEMBER 14, 2025**

The District 12 meeting was held on December 14, 2025, as a hybrid meeting at Queen Street in Morganton and on Zoom. There were 18 voting members. The meeting was opened with the Serenity Prayer.

**SECRETARY** – Lory reads last month’s minutes, which were accepted.

**TRESURER** – Dianne reviews her report, which was accepted.

**DCM** – Marty reviews his Assembly report sent in a past email. Some issues at GSO were the money given to support the Grapevine, money budgeted to upfit offices to save rent in the future, and that the Grapevine has a podcast. Area issues included there were around 900 people at the Convention (making money overall), sites for upcoming events, and the passing of the budget.

**ADCM** – Scotty is absent.

**LCM BURKE** – Open position.

**LCM CATAWBA** – Meredith is absent.

**LCM CALDWELL** – Open position.

**CFC (CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES COORDINATOR)** – James states that he plans to bring food into the prisons for the Christmas meetings, and that he still needs volunteers.

**CPC/PI (COOPERATION WITH PROFESSIONAL COMMUNITY/PUBLIC INFORMATION)** – Dan is absent.

**TFC (TREATMENT FACILITIES COORDINATOR)** – Hooks states that there is nothing new to report; all is good. He will bring up an issue in new business.

**REGISTRAR** – April is absent.

**ACCESSIBILITIES** – Open position.

**PUBLICATIONS** – Kevin states that anything needing to be listed in the publications need to be sent to him 2 weeks prior to the next district meeting.

**EVENTS** – Kerry states that there are flyers available for the Alcothon. The band will play between the dinner and speaker meetings. She reviews time slots and group sponsors for the Alcothon.

**GRAPEVINE REP** – John is absent.

**WEBMASTER** – Marty states that all is up to date.

**OLD BUSINESS** – Dianne presents next year’s potential budget. A motion to approve was passed.

**NEW BUSINESS** – Hooks states he has enough volunteers to start a daytime detox meeting, which was approved. Marty moves to eliminate the Registrar position and transfer those duties to the DCM. The motion was passed.
