SECRETARY REPORT – DISTRICT 12 MEETING – MARCH 8, 2026

The District 12 meeting was held on MARCH 8, 2026, as a hybrid meeting at the Caldwell House in Lenoir and on Zoom. There were 18 voting members. The meeting was opened with the Serenity Prayer.

SECRETARY – Lory reads last month’s minutes, which were accepted, with correction of the location and date of the next meeting.

TRESURER – Dianne reviews her report, which was accepted.

DCM – Marty states there were 4 calls to the hot line. He reviews the Area Committee Meeting in Durham, from which he arrived earlier today. He states the Plain Language Big Book Audio will be out in June; that the 5<sup>th</sup> edition will be considered by the April Conference and may be available for publication; that the Area continues to investigate cost cutting; that the Grapevine is doing better financially. He reviews all the upcoming events; he states he will be sending out that information in an email and on the website. He states he is reviewing the group information he gathered recently for the registrar.

ADCM – Scotty talks about the numbers at meetings in his area doing well. He also shares that the Newton-Conover groups are needing women to support some female newcomers in their area.

LCM BURKE – Open position.

LCM CATAWBA – Meredith is absent.

LCM CALDWELL – Open position.

CFC (CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES COORDINATOR) – James states he has nothing new to report. Please contact him if anyone is interested in attending the prison meetings.

CPC/PI (COOPERATION WITH PROFESSIONAL COMMUNITY/PUBLIC INFORMATION) – Dan is absent and sends in a report that he is stepping down as the CPC/PI coordinator.

TFC (TREATMENT FACILITIES COORDINATOR) – Hooks states he has two applications approved for volunteers at Jonas Hill Treatment Center, and that he will be meeting with the staff to plan the format and timing of a meeting there.

ACCESSIBILITIES – Open

PUBLICATIONS – Kevin states the supplies are good for now. He will need to step down by August.

EVENTS – Kerry states that June 13<sup>th</sup> will be Unity Day, and that the church is scheduled; Dianne states she sent the check. She would like to have volunteers to help plan the event, get a speaker, and work with groups to cover the workshops.

GRAPEVINE REP – John is absent. He is removed from the Grapevine position, making that an open position.

WEBMASTER – Marty apologizes for being late updating the information this month. He will add all Area information soon.

OLD BUSINESS – No old business.

NEW BUSINESS – (1) Times for the Unity Day dinner and speaker meeting will be looked at by the events committee, with the District supporting the events committee making the evening flow smoother. (2) Byron stands for the Publication position. A motion to accept was made and passed. (3) Other group events include the Granite Falls BBQ will be on June 20<sup>th</sup>; the High Noon Fall Picnic will be on September 12<sup>th</sup>; the Veteran’s Stand Down will be at CVCC in April and will need volunteers to attend and support AA with literature, veteran connection, etc.
